It's easy to get to Har Sinai

From Princeton/Lawrenceville/Hopewell/Pennington

Route #95 South to Exit 4 NORTH (Route 31). Keep right on ramp and merge right onto Route #31 North (Pennington Road). Stay in the right lane. Just AFTER the first light (Denow Road), take the jughandle to the right and merge onto Denow Road, staying to the right. Drive through the light (you are now CROSSING Route #31) and take the SECOND driveway to the left into the Har Sinai parking lot.

From Pennsylvania via Route #95

Take Route #95 North and cross the Scudders Falls Bridge into New Jersey. Take Exit #4 (Route #31/Pennington Road NORTH). At the top of the ramp, turn left onto Route #31. Cross OVER Route #95 and pass through the first light. Stay in the right lane. Just AFTER the next light (Denow Road), take the jughandle to the right and merge onto Denow Road, staying to the right. Drive through the light (you are now CROSSING Route #31) and take the SECOND driveway to the left into the Har Sinai parking lot.
