WHAT IS MUSIC & MEMORY?

Grounded in extensive research, Music & Memory helps people living with a wide rage of cognitive and physical challenges to find renewed joy in life through musical favorites.

HOW DOES PERSONALIZED MUSIC MAKE A DIFFERENCE?

- Beloved music reduces depression and anxiety, and can moderate pain
- Musical favorites tap deep memories and can improve quality of life
- Music increases socialization, decreases isolation and restores identity
- Cherished music can improve mood and behavior



WHAT WILL YOU RECEIVE?

Your participation will be administered by a JFCS licensed social worker and you'll receive:

- An iPod Shuffle, headphones and a personally-selected playlist of songs
- An assessment to determine music preferences
- A home visit to instruct the participant and/or the caregiver on how to use the iPod
- Follow-up to evaluate the program and modify playlists
