Secure@Home® is a non-profit, non-sectarian program from Jewish Family & Children's Service designed to help older adults age safely, comfortably and independently in their own homes.

We're here to help you and your loved ones by providing an umbrella of services to promote healthy aging and "aging in place."

CARE MANAGEMENT BENEFITS

As part of your S@H membership, you will have access to a team of geriatric care managers who will coordinate all health-related or other needed services during crisis or illness. We advocate as well as provide liaison and support for you and your family.

Complete Assessment

A care manager will visit you in your own home to talk to you and your family about your overall health and wellness and any concerns you have. We will also do a home safety evaluation.

Comprehensive Care Plan

We incorporate all information into a personalized care management plan. This includes medications, physicians, emergency information and an overall picture of your health.

24-Hour Emergency Phone Availability

We're available 24/7 to manage all after-hour emergencies — whether someone's been hospitalized or has lost electricity — we're there.

Information & Referral

Contact us if you need a referral to any health-related service including physicians, hospitals, homecare agencies, rehabilitation facilities, etc.

Monthly Hello

We reach out to you with a friendly hello each month — more frequently if you desire.

HEALTHY AGING SERVICES

Chore Corps

You can have a volunteer help with light chores around the house such as changing light bulbs or smoke detector batteries, hanging pictures or moving boxes.

Preferred Providers

Looking for a reputable plumber, handyman electrician, snow removal service or other service professional? A quick call is all it takes.

Cultural & Wellness Programs

You'll be invited to special programs and events — from exercise to balance to cooking to safety.

Transportation

You can take advantage of several transportation options so you can travel safely to medical appointments, shopping, social events and more.

Medication Management

For an additional fee, a Registered Nurse will visit you in your home to help you manage your medications and fill your pill boxes on a regular basis.

WHAT WE WILL DO



- Have care managers accompany you to doctors appointments
- Have volunteers change light bulbs and smoke detector batteries, assist with computers and organize paperwork
- Respond to after-hours emergencies in the evening and on weekends
- Coordinate all of your care in your home, hospital or rehab facility
- Help to provide day-to-day necessities such as food and medicine
- Work with home health agencies to ensure you get the aides you need
- Help you address insurance issues including Medicare and long term care policies
- Refer a medical professional who makes house calls
- Arrange for transportation to medical appointments
- Provide the hospital with any relevant medical and contact information
- Work with discharge planners to arrange post-hospital care
- Help maintain contact with loved ones and friends and update them on your progress
- Help you determine if your home needs temporary or permanent modifications
